EDUCATION & MENTORSHIP

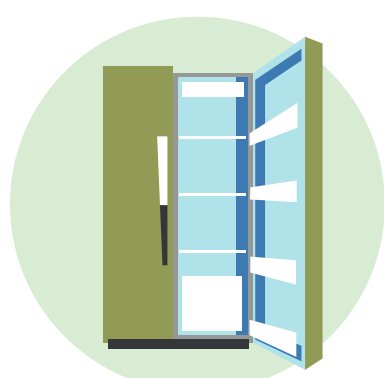
Resources and instruction on farming practices and running a business.
